• The Board moved to approve the Travis Mechanical bid for a new coil and refrigerant for cooling unit for the Elementary building for \$10,000. *Motion by Pierschbacher second by Heltenberg.* Motion carried unanimously.

#### INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

The School Board reviewed the latest guidance and information received from the Governor's Office, the Iowa Department of Education and the Iowa Department of Public Health regarding the start of the school year. A draft version of student learning options were highlighted, as well as a district decision tree. The District is finalizing practices and protocols for returning with students in person and on site on August 26 that have been discussed and developed by staff to date. Students with medical concerns and conditions will have appropriate options to ensure health and safety. Parents will be surveyed regarding student needs and selected learning options and data will be reviewed by the Board in August prior to the start of the school year.

The District has now formally purchased both 204 West Chestnut and 200 N Walnut. The N Walnut Property is in escrow until all paperwork is finalized. Upon receipt of the asbestos inspection report, the District will secure an asbestos removal quote and move forward with asbestos removal on both properties. The cost of property purchase, inspection, mitigation and demolition will be covered through District SAVE funds.

Musco lighting has installed the mini-pitch system at the elementary playground. This project was funded by Musco Lighting and Kick It Forward. The court will be painted green. The District is coordinating with the City of Lamoni and local contractors for the electrical work.

#### UPCOMING DATES

Regular school board meeting scheduled for August 12, 2020. The structure of the meeting will be determined by the state mandates and public health guidelines.
