Superintendent Coffelt's report was shared, which included the following highlights:

- The District Staff Handbook for 2017-2018 is in development. The District will work with staff and utilize guidance from the lowa Association of School Boards and the lowa Department of Education to build this document.
- The preschool playground concrete foundation has been completed. District is expecting a September 13 installation of playground equipment for preschool.
- School Board election will be held Tuesday, September 12. We have 3 open positions and 3 people within the community running for School Board positions.
- The Back-to-School Fair on August 1 was held at the Lamoni Community Center. This fair offered a variety of services such as
  dental check-ups, meningococcal vaccinations, lead screenings, gently used sports equipment, clothing and shoes, free bike
  helmets and bike checks. Free walking tacos were served by the SAFE coalition.
