DISTRICT REPORTS:

Superintendent Coffelt's report was shared, which included the following highlights:

- School Improvement Advisory Committee (SIAC) met Monday, April 3, 2017.
- Funding for the 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant was approved for the 2017-2018 school year. This funding supports before, after and summer school programs for students. The grant was a joint effort between three Decatur County Community School Districts, including: Lamoni, Central Decatur and Mormon Trail.
- Middle School wiring and high school gym lighting projects will begin this summer with KCL Engineering overseeing the project.
- The District is taking sealed bids to dispose of a District owned Massey-Ferguson Tractor. If interested, contact Bob Kelly.
- Bluegrass Conference approved Grand View Christian's request to withdraw from the Bluegrass Athletic Conference at the end of the 2016-2017 athletic season.
- Bob Kelly is working with contractors to design and develop a preschool playground space at the school, which will be installed Summer 2017.
- Lamoni School District is moving from the South West to South Central Iowa Bandmasters Association.
