From the Desk of Dr. Dykens

Dear Parents and Community Members,

The Lamoni Community School District is constantly revising our policies to reflect the ever-changing world we live in today. The educational landscape across the country coupled with the new state mandates on school safety, are forcing us to reevaluate our own processes. Because of these facts and our desire to ensure the safety of each child, teacher, and staff member within the district, we are moving forward with the following procedural processes.

1. Starting September 4th, we are asking that ALL parents and visitors refrain from walking the kids to their classrooms. The students should know their way to each classroom by this time and this will help with congestion at the school. We will have a teacher or staff member present at the door to help some of the younger kids. The parent or visitor may walk the child into the building, if desired, but needs to stay at the STOP sign within the lobby.
2. Each parent or visitor will need to check into the office once entering the building. The parent or visitor will be asked to remain at the office. The administrative assistant in the office will call the child's class and have the child sent to the office. Exceptions to this will involve volunteer opportunities predetermined by the teacher and communicated with the administrative assistant.
3. Items brought to school, during the school day, will be left with the administrative assistant in the office. The administrative assistant will ensure that the item is delivered to the child.
4. All visitors coming into the school district will need to sign into the office and will be given a visitors badge / sticker to display. All visitors need to communicate reason for visit and with whom they are visiting, and that staff member must clear their visitation. The badge / sticker must be displayed in plain sight on the visitor. Upon completion of visit, the visitor must sign out at the office, return badge / sticker and leave building.
5. All communication for student tardy or absence MUST be communicated to the administrative assistant in the office. Email or phone call will suffice. Communicating solely with teachers will no longer be accepted.
6. Pick-up will occur at the playground at 3:05 pm. Parents are expected to pick up their kids at the playground entrance on Elm Street near the Middle School parking lot or in the Elementary School Lobby if walking.

We know that change is hard, but we are looking to increase the safety of our kids and school district. We thank you in advance for your adherence to these new policies as we move forward with our school safety plan.
