ISASP Testing Is Here!

Lamoni Community Schools, Grades 3-11, will be participating in Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) tests on April 19th and 26th (5th only). The results of these tests reflect what is being taught in our classrooms and how students are progressing toward grade-level expectations. It is extremely important that your student be in attendance on those days so we ask that you schedule all appointments and outings accordingly.

- Get your child to school on time!
