Notice To Parents Of Kindergarten and 9th Grade Students

All children enrolling in kindergarten and 9th grade in an Iowa school are required to have a dental screening. Dental screening forms are available at the school or from your dentist. Dental screenings need to be completed and forms turned into the school nurse by October 1. If you need a form or have questions, please call the school nurse at 784-3422.

Notice To Parents Of 3rd Grade Students

All children enrolling in 3rd grade in an Iowa school are required to have a vision screening. Vision screening forms are available at the school or from your eye doctor. Vision screenings need to be completed and forms turned into the school nurse by October 1. If you need a form or have questions, please call the school nurse at 784-3422.

Visitors to School

Parents / guardians will NOT be allowed into the district past the Elementary and High School offices. This will be in effect until at the end of the first semester. This includes all parties, drop-off and pick-up of the students. Parent / Teacher conferences, IEP meetings and 504 meetings will be the only exceptions at this time.

Pick-up and Drop-off

This year's Elementary school pick-up and drop-off will ONLY occur on the west side of the playground. This will help to ensure the safety and security of all as we try to mitigate the COVID virus.

Face Coverings

Facemasks will be required when social distancing can not occur or around individuals with compromised health concerns. However, it is the recommendation of the Lamoni Community School District, in accordance with other governing bodies, that because facemasks can play a substantial role in mitigating the contraction and spread of COVID-19 (if properly worn, maintained and cleaned), in order to provide the maximum amount of safety and security, their use is recommended while at school.

No outside food or drink

We will no longer allow outside food or drinks to be brought into our district, which includes food for parties (birthday or holiday). The only exception will be lunches brought from home each day. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
