### Lamoni Pool Grant Application

The following information is needed and required for families to receive a voucher for a free 2022 Summer Family Pool Pass and/or swim lessons. You will be notified by mail of your family's eligibility. All applications will be reviewed on first come, first serve basis. Incomplete applications or applications without income verification will NOT be considered until all necessary documents have been received. Also, if your family or certain individuals in your family received a free pass last year but did not attend the required 10 times, you *may* be disqualified from receiving a pass for the current year.

Please fill in ALL of the following information. You must have children from ages 0-18 living in your household to apply. Children over the age of 18 will NOT be eligible to be included on the family pass. Only immediate family members living in the household will be considered.

- Then you will make your counseling appointment. You will receive a reminder call the day before your scheduled appointment.
