Elementary specials include PE, Art, Music and Library for Kindergarten and First Graders. We use a four day (A-D)schedule. See below for the schedule:




2-5 grade students will use a five day specials schedule which includes Art, Library, PE, Music and Computers. See below for the schedule:


Clinic: 2 - 4:30 p.m. ♀ Shaw Center Game: 6 p.m.

If you care for a child between the ages of birth to eight years, join us for the ACT Raising Safe Kids series.


#### You'll learn to help your child:
