

Pick-up and Drop Off of Students

Now that our construction is complete, we would like to remind students and parents of our morning drop off procedures.



Students may only enter the building at their designated door and time.

All other doors are to remain locked/closed.

Elementary begins at 8am and ends at 3:05pm. For the safety of our students, elementary school drop-off and pick-up will occur ONLY on the west side of the playground on Elm Street. We ask that students not be dropped off prior to 7:30am unless they are registered for Before School Exploration Academy.

Change in After School Plans

For the welfare and safety of our students, we ask that parents create a consistent after school plan for their student(s). Changing plans frequently can lead to feelings of stress and confusion for students and adversely affect their learning experience. Changes in plans need to be communicated to the Elementary Office **prior** to 2pm. Frequent changes in plans may be address by the principal. Our goal is to keep your child safe!
