Change of Clothes- PK thru 2nd

Please send an extra set of clothes with your child, to keep at school. Spills and accidents are a common occurrence and being prepared lessens the stress of those situations for the student.

Visitors to School/Pick-up and Drop Off

Parents and guardians will NOT be allowed into the district past the Elementary and High School offices. **This includes drop-off and pick-up of the students** even on the first day of school. Staff will be available to assist your child to their classroom until they are comfortable walking their on their own.

Elementary begins at 8am and ends at 3:05pm. This year's Elementary school pick-up and drop-off for K-5 students will ONLY occur on the west side of the playground. For the safety of our students, we ask that student NOT be dropped off prior to 7:30. Students arriving after 8:00 am will be considered tardy.

Face Coverings

In accordance with House file 847, schools and school boards no longer have the authority to require face coverings at school. This includes during the school day, as well as at school events, athletic activities, practices, camps, etc, and on buses. However, face coverings are welcomed if families choose to do so. Students and families will be supported in their choice!

Girl Scouts Informational Night Wednesday, September 22

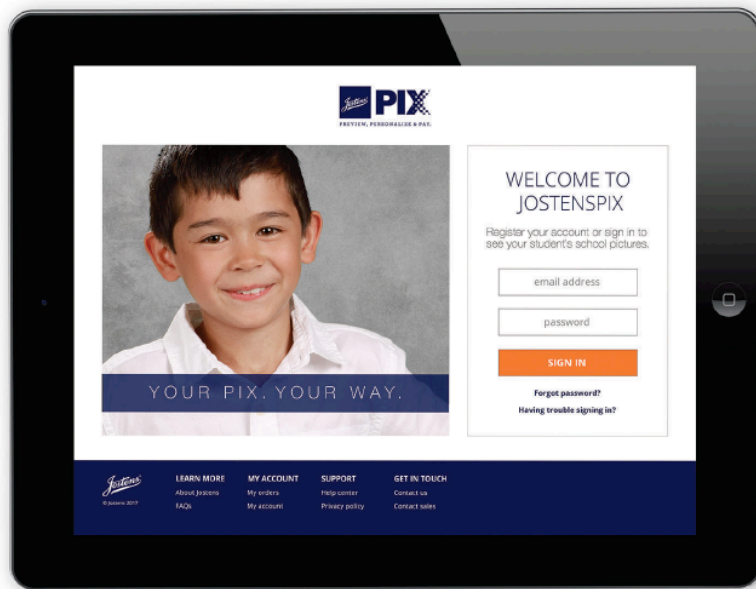

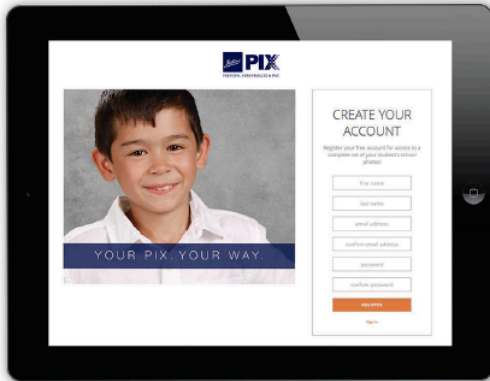

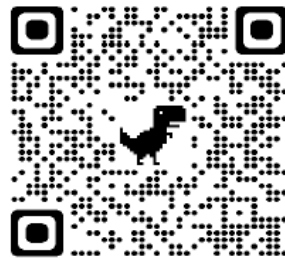
The Marion County Public Health I-Smile™ @ School program is offering **no-cost** dental services for children at your elementary school.

The following services may be provided by dental hygienists:

- Dental Screening – a simple look in the mouth to check for cavities.
- Fluoride Varnish – a sticky liquid that coats all teeth to help make them stronger and prevent tooth decay.
- Dental Sealants – a tooth-colored coating that is painted on the back teeth to protect them from food, germs, and acid that cause tooth decay.
- Oral Health Education – lessons to help students learn about healthy teeth and mouths.

After the services are provided to your child, a letter will be sent home to you with the results. Please note that dental screenings **do not** replace regular dental check-ups. Your child should visit the dentist at least once a year for a complete exam.
