Changing After School Plans

Please notify the elementary office of any changes to your child's after school plans prior to 2:00pm. The end of the day is a hectic time and we want to insure that all relevant parties have been notified. Also, please try and solidify your weekly after school plans prior to the week starting.

Breakfast at School

Your child can start the day off with a healthy breakfast in the cafeteria from 7:30-7:55am. Please drop your child off at the main High School entrance no earlier than 7:30am. Statistics show children learn better when they start the day off with breakfast!

Information Changes

Please notify the elementary office (784-3422) if you have any changes in phone numbers, address, emergency contacts. etc... so we can keep your child's records up to date. It is important to be able to contact parents if there is a concern or emergency.

Visitors to School

Parents / guardians will NOT be allowed into the district past the Elementary and High School offices. This will be in effect until further notice. This includes all parties, as well as drop-off and pick-up of the students. Parent / Teacher conferences, IEP meetings and 504 meetings will be the only exceptions at this time.

Pick-up and Drop-off

This year's Elementary school pick-up and drop-off will ONLY occur on the west side of the playground. This will help to ensure the safety and security of all as we try to mitigate the COVID virus.

Face Coverings

Facemasks will be required when social distancing cannot occur or around individuals with compromised health concerns. It is the recommendation of the Lamoni Community School District, in accordance with other governing bodies, that because facemasks can play a substantial role in mitigating the contraction and spread of COVID-19 (if properly worn, maintained and cleaned), in order to provide the maximum amount of safety and security, their use is recommended while at school.

No outside food or drink

We will no longer allow outside food or drinks to be brought into our district. This includes food for parties (birthday or holiday). The only exception will be lunches brought from home each day. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
