### Weight Room Upgrades - Dekko Grant

Larry (JR) Johnson (Class of 1998) and current Lamoni Business Teacher/ HS Football Coach, and Chris Cougill, Middle School Resource Room Teacher and multisport coach, wrote and received a \$40,000 grant from the Dekko Foundation for upgrades to the Weight Room and further development of the Fitness Program in Lamoni Schools. The current Weight Room is in the elementary building (old lunchroom or old elementary gymnasium depending on when you attended school in this building). The grant awards \$20,000 up front and an additional \$20,000 on a 1 to 1 match from donations toward this project to make a total of at least \$60,000.

Decatur County is so grateful to be one of thirteen counties in the United States where Mr. Chet Dekko had manufacturing plants, producing wire harnesses. The original Lamoni plant is on South Smith Street across from Big G Lake, and is currently owned by Industrial Hardfacing. A Foundation established in Mr. Dekko's name awards grants to increase economic freedom through education for youth ages birth to eighteen. Lamoni has been privileged to receive Dekko Foundation grants including a grant when the new high school was built to help continually work to make the school the center of our community with outreach and connections to many community partners and youth serving organizations.

If you would like to add your support to this project, checks could be written to Lamoni Community Schools, 202 North Walnut, Lamoni, IA 50140, and note that the money is to be used for the fitness room.
